 that there was surveyed the 14th of the Second month 1684 unto James
 Price purchaser a certaine tract of Land in the township of Radnor in the
 County of Chester begining at a Corner post in the Line of Roger Hughes
 Land from thence north, north west one hundred perches to a Stake sett in
 the Line of John Evans from thence by a line of marked trees 486 p^{cs}ches
 East, North East to a stake sett in Road deciding the sd township and the
 Land of John Eckly and Companys Land from thence south, south east
 along the sd Road to another post sett in the line of David Merediths Land
 from thence by a line of marked trees west south west 486 p^{cs}ches to the
 place of begining Containeing & Laid out for three hundred acres of Land.
