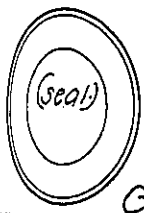


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of John Packer of the County of Chester That we would

Grant him to take up the Quantity of five hundred Acres of Land in part of One thousand acres the Original purchase made of the Late Proprietor by John Boyd of Luckington in the County of Wilts. by deeds of Lease & Release the 11th & 12th dayes of October Anno 1681 the Right whereof by Sundry Mesne Conveyances being now Vested in the said John Packer. These are to Authorize & Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd in part of the aforesaid purchase according to the Method of Townships appointed the said quantity of five hundred acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given Under our Hands and the lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of December Anno Dni. 1726.
