



Land surveyed unto Griffith Philips In y^e great Valey In y^e County Chest-
 er viz beginning at a Corner marked white oak Saplin, standing in y^e line of Ev-
 an Lewis Thence by y^e sd Lewis's land, David Howels land and John Earls land,
 west 17° South 250 perches to a Corner post, thence by a line of marked trees and
 by vacant Land north north west 35 perches and one fourth part of a perch to
 a Corner post, thence by a line of marked trees and by vacant Land East 17°
 north 250 perches to a Corner marked black oak Saplin, thence by a line of marked
 Trees and by vacant Land South south East 35 perches and 1/4 of a perch to y^e
 place of beginning Containing 55 acres of Land.
