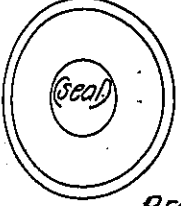


Pennsylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the Request of Hans Pupather now of the Township of Strasburg in this

Province that we would Grant him to take up in or near the said Township the quan-

tity of Seven hundred acres of Land for which he agrees to pay to the Proprietors Use Seventy Pounds

Money of the said Province for the whole and the yearly quitrent of one Shilling Sterling for every

hundred acres. These are to Authorize and Require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed unto

the said Hans Pupather in or near the place aforesaid according to the Method of Townships

appointed the said quantity of Seven hundred acres of Land that hath not been already sur-

veyd nor appropriated nor is seated by the Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secret-

ary's Office which survey in case the said Hans fulfill the above agreement within three

Months after the date hereof shall be valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had

never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our hands & seal of the

Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 27<sup>th</sup> day of 7<sup>br</sup> Anno Dni 1717.
