

This may certify That by Vertue of a Warrant from ye Commissioners of Property y^e 28th day of August 1715 For Laying out unto David Powell Eight hundred Acres of Land in this Province There was Surveyed & laid out on y^e 15th of April in y^e Year 1717, in p^t of y^e sd Quantity A Certain Tract or pcell of Land near Manatawny in y^e County of Philad^{ia} Beginning at a certain White oak marked by Thomas Fairman for a Corner of a Tract of Land sometimes Reputed y^e London Company's Land Then by y^e same South East one hundred & fourteen fches to a Post Then West South West by a line of marked trees Two hundred & forty fches Then North North West by a line of marked Trees One hundred & thirty three fches to a Post Then East North East Two hundred & Forty fches Then South South East Twenty one fches to y^e place of Beginning Containing Two hundred Acres.
