



In pursuance of a contract of the first of Nov^r 1827 with the members of the Board of property of the State of Penn^a and the authority therein given, there was surveyed & calculated by virtue of an Appn N^o 2115 granted by the proprietary government to John Hill the 3d of April 1769. The above Tract of land situate on the North East branch of Plum^b Creek, in the Township of Plum^b, Allegheny County, containing three hundred Acres, one hundred & twenty perches and allowance of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ c^t.
