

By Vertue of a Warrant from the Commiss^{rs} of Property dated y^e 6th day of the 2nd 1702 for Resurveying unto Robert Jones of Meikion a Tract of land in his possession within the Bounds of the Welch Tract being part of five hundred acres laid out to William Shardlow and from him by Vertue of several meant Conveyances derived to the said Robert Jones and is reputed to Contain one hundred and fifty acres

Resurvey'd the 19th day of the 12th Month 170³ unto Robert Jones a Tract of Land in Meikion in the Welch Tract beginning at a post by the River Schuylkill att the Corner of other land of the said Robert Jones and running by the same west Sixteen degrees South three hundred and thirty two perches to a post Then by W^m Shardlows land North west Eighty eight perches to a post Then East Sixteen degr North by the said Shardlow's land three hundred & thirty two perches to a hickory tree by Schuylkill Then Down the same on the Several courses thereof Eighty nine perches to the place of the Beginning Containing one hundred and sixty five acres
