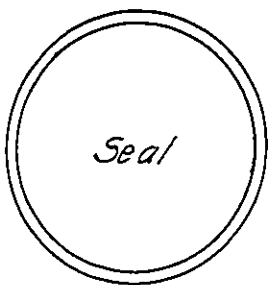

Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province of Philad^{ia} the 22^d of y^e 10th Moth 1701.
