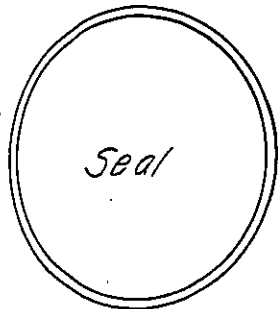

At the Request of David Lewis of Haverford That We would grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land situate in the said Township Convey'd to him for one hundred Acres by the Executors of Sarah Eckly's last Will being formerly part of Jm^o Burges Land: These are to Authorize and require thee exactly to resurvey the said Land according to its ancient Lines and Boundaries and if it fall short of the quantity it was laid out for then to make up the same out of any such adjacent Land as can conveniently be spared for it ~~the same~~, and make Returns into the general Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 24th of the 2^d Month 1704
