

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commission^{rs} of property bearing date 9th of November 1702 for Resurveying to William Jenkins a certain Tract of Land laid out to the said William Jenkins in Duffein Mawr within the bounds of the Welch tract for two hundred and fifty acres in right and part of his Original purchase of 1000 Acres. Resurvey'd the 2^d day of the 1st month 170³ the said tract of Land beginning at a post at the corner of David Jones his land Thence by the line of the said Jones his land South South East four hundred Ninety and Six perches to a corner post Thence by vacant land West South West one hundred twenty ^{and two} perches to a post at the corner of James Thomas his Land Thence by the line of the said James his Land North North West four hundred Ninety and Six perches to a Maple tree Thence East North East one hundred twenty and ^{two} perches to the beginning Containing three hundred and seventy eight acres Resurvey'd by David Powel and Returned into the General Surveyors office at philad^a the 10th of the 3^d month 1703
