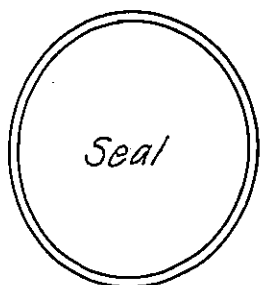

At the Request of Henry Lewis That We would grant him a Resurvey of two parcels of Land within the Welch Tract, the one laid out in Haverford for four hundred Acres the other in Goshen for One hundred and eighty Acres both by Vertue of a Genl Warr^t from the Prop^{ty} for laying out the s^d Tract dated the first Month 1684 ~~and~~ in right of Lewis David first Purchaser of 3000 Acres & now in the s^d Henry's Possession: These are to Require thee forthwith to resurvey ^{to the said Hen: Lewis} the said two tracts or parcels of Land Scituate as aforesaid, and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary, ~~and~~ Who is to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16th of the 12th Month 1701
