

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand of the Commiss^{rs} of Property and the seal of the Province bearing date the 25th day of the 1st month Ordering a Resurvey on the several Tracts of land in the Townships of Chichester Bethel Concord & Brommington

There is Resurvey'd to Robert Langham a Tract of land situate in the Township of Chichester (but not within the Limits of the land held by the Town Patent) beginning at a White oak by stony Run from thence by Henry Worly's land North ^{six} sixty degrees east eight perches to a post from thence south south east fifty six perches to a white oak thence south by east two hundred seventy four perches to a Corner black oak by the side of a Marsh from thence North seventy three degrees east twenty perche to a Corner stone (the two lines last mentioned Running by Morten Gornute's land) and from the said stone extending through the said Marsh south ^{by} east thirty six perches to the River Delaware thence down the same south fifty three degrees west fifty eight perches to the mouth of stony Run thence up the several Courses of the said Run the several distances added together four hundred sixty two perch to the place of beginning Containing one hundred thirty three acres Resurvey'd by Isaac Taylor the last of ^{the} 1702 Revised in the Gen^l Surveyors office
