At the Request of Maurice Llewellyn That We would grant him a Resurvey on four hundred and twenty Acres of Land laid out in the Township of Haverford in three Several Tracts by Vertue of a General Warr<sup>t</sup> from the Proprietary bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> of the first Month 1684, ~~in right of his~~ three hundred and ninety Acres thereof in right of his own Original Purchase of the Prop<sup>ty</sup> and the remaining thirty in right of Rees Rytharch purchaset under Lewis David: These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said Maurice Llewellyn the said three several Tracts of Land in his and his Childrens possession now being in the Township aforesaid and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee Attested by the Secretary ~~and~~ who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office.
