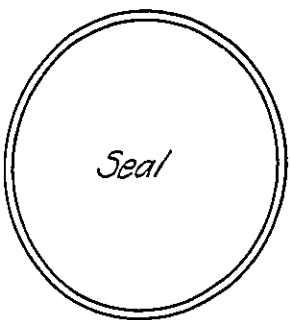


Pennsylvania*Seal**By the Comm^{rs} of Property*

At the Request of George Lea that we would grant him to take upp two hundred acres of land adjoyning on the land of Nathaniel Newlin on the South east side thereof in the Manor of Rocklands at a certain Price agreed on: These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyed to the said George Lea the said number of two hundred acres of land in the Place aforesaid and make Returns thereof into the Secretaryes Office: Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 17th day of 10^{ber} 1701
