

At the Request of John Lewis Sett^t That we would grant him a Resurvey
 on three hundred and fifty Acres of Land laid out in Haverford within the Welch
 Tract to Henry Lewis Purchaser under Lewis David by Virtue of a General Warrant
 from the Proprietary for Laying out the said Tract dated in the first Month 1684
 it by Virtue of a Purchase from the sd Henry now in the sd John's Possession; These
 are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said John Lewis the sd quantity of
 three hundred and fifty Acres of Land and make Returns thereof into the General
 Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof
 to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Copy of thy
 Return into his Office - Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at
 Philadelphia the 16th day of the 12th Month 1701
