

In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 27th day of September 1717 There was Surveyd and Laid out on the 25th day of October then next ensuing for Peter Letman a Tract or Parcel of Land in Strasburg in the County of Chester Beginning at a hickery tree at a corner of Isaac Lefevre's land and running by the same South by East twenty perches to a post Then by the land of Joseph English West by South eighty three perches to a post Then by the land of Michael Darriger North by West two hundred ninety two perches to a post Then East by North by the Land of Coll^d John Evatts and other land One hundred eighty two perches to a post Then South by East two hundred seventy two perches to a post Then by the said Lefevres land West by South ninety six perches to the place of beginning Containing three hundred acres with an allowance of Six per Cent. Returned into the Secre^{ts} Office the 27th of January 172⁸/₉
