That We would grant him a Resurvey on one hundred Acres of Land laid out in Haverford within the Welch Tract by Vertue of a General Warrant from the Prop'ry for laying out the sd Tract dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of the first Month 1684 in right of Henry Lewis Purchaser under Lewis David Original Purchaser of 5000 Acres and now in the sd John's possession These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the sd John Lewis the said one hundred Acres of Land scituate as aforesaid and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv'd thee Attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16<sup>th</sup> of the 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701
