

Pursuant to a Warrant under the hand and seal of the Proprietary and Governour to me directed bearing date the 16th day of the 10th month 1700 I do hereby certify that I have caused to be Resurveyed unto Richard Hilliard a certain Tract of Land situate in the Township of Dublin in the County of Philadelphia which had been laid out the 30th of the 12th month 1687 by virtue of the Proprietary and Governour's Warrant bearing date the 29th day of the 2^d month 1683 unto his Father Richard Hilliard beginning at a Corner post dividing it from George Stmedley's Land from thence by a Line of marked trees North East five hundred and ten perches to another post sett in the ground from thence South East by a Line of marked trees dividing it from Joseph Fisher's Land ninety five perches and three quarters to a marked Chestnut from thence by a Line of marked trees dividing it from Robert Whittott's Land South West five hundred and ten perches to a post sett in the ground from thence North West by a Line of marked trees ninety five perches and three quarters to the place of beginning containing and laid out for three hundred and five acres thirty two perches and a half of Land. Resurveyed the 19th day of the 10th month 1700 and Returned according to the above said Resurvey and bounds into the Proprietary and Governour's Secretary's Office the 28th day of the said 10th month 1700
