



and the Territories thereunto belonging -

At y<sup>e</sup> Request of William Harmer y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to take up a Lott in  
y<sup>e</sup> City, he bought of Thomas Tuckett of Two hundred and fifty Acres  
Purchase of Jno<sup>o</sup> Harris of Gotacker. These are to will and require thee  
forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in y<sup>e</sup> Streets sett  
out for Purchasers of y<sup>e</sup> like Quantity, and make returns thereof into my  
Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 19<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>rd</sup> 1683.
