


By Vertue of a War^t from Edward Pettington Survey^r: Gener^l bearing date y^e 5th of y^e 8th m^o: 1700 directed unto me I do hereby Certify unto his office that I have Surveyd and Laid out the 14th of the Ninth m^o: Ensueing unto Edward Hopton a Certaine Tract of Land in the County of Philadelphia beginneing at a stak in the Line of Richard Whittpaine & Companys Land and by the said Line North East 306 perches to another post sett up in the said Line from thence South East by a Line of marked trees 131 perche to another stak sett in the ground from thence South West by a Line of Marked trees 306 perches to a stak sett in the ground and from thence North West by a Line of marked trees 131 perche to the place of beginneing Containeing and Laid out for two hundred and fifty acres of Land
