 that I have Reasurveyd and Laid out the 19th of the said mo^o a Certain tract of Land

 Smedlys Land from thence by a Line of marked trees North East five hundred
 seven perches to another stake sett in the ground from thence South East by the Line

 perche to a Chestnut marked from thence by a Line of marked trees deviding
 it from Robert Whitters Land ~~west~~ South West five hundred and ten perches
 to a post sett in the ground from thence North West by a Line of marked
 trees 95 $\frac{3}{4}$ p^{erch} to the place of begining Containeing and Laid out for
 three Hundred & three acors & twenty five p^{erches}
