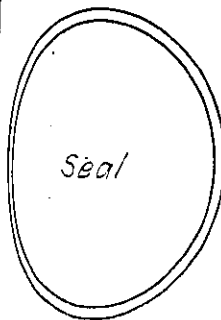


By the Comm^{rs} Impowred to Granting Lotts and Land in the Province
