Markham dated y^e 5th of y^e 8th mo: 1682 unto John Day 210 Acres of Land in y^e County of Philadelphia & Townsh^p of Oxford beginning at a corner marked white oak being a corner tree of W^m Brown's Land from thence North East by y^e said Browns Line of trees 480 perches to a corner marked stake from thence South East by a line of marked trees 70 perches to a corner marked saplin oak from thence South West by y^e Land of Nehemiah Mitchell 480 perches to a corner marked stake from thence N W by a line of marked trees 70 perches to y^e first mentioned white oak, Returned according to which above said survey and bounds into y^e Proprietary's Secretary's Office y^e 15th of y^e 5th month 1684
