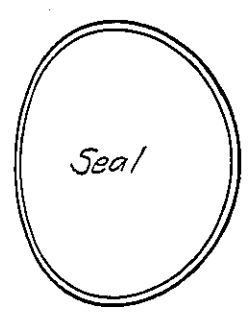


Pennsylvania ss

At the Request of Henry Hayes lately arrived in this Province That we would Grant him to take up the City Lots and Proportion of Liberty Land Appurtenant to the Original Purchase of One Thousand Acres made by Richard Hanns of Oxfordshire These are to Authorize ^{three} to survey and lay out to the said Henry the City Lots aforesaid where they originally fell, or as near the same as may be together with Sixteen Acres of Land within the Liberties over Skuylkill, if there be so much Vacant to be found, and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia & a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 3^d day of September 1705
