



By Vertue of a Warr<sup>t</sup> from Edward Pennington Survey<sup>r</sup> Generall bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> of ye 10<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>e</sup> 1700 directed unto me I do hereby Certiefy into his Office that I have Surveyd and Laid out unto Edward Singlton Atturmy for Richard Haines a Certaine tract of Land in the County of Philla delphia beginneing at a stak sett in the ground by a Roade deviding it from Limbrik Township from thenc by a Litte of marked trees North East 500 perches to a post sett in the ground hard by a blak oke marked from thenc North west by a Litte of marked trees 160 perches to a Corner Stak deviding it from Nathaim Pughes Land from thenc South west by a Litte of marked trees 500 perches to a blak oke marked from thenc South East 160 perches by a Litte of marked trees to the place of beginneing Containeing and Laid out for five hundred acres of Land the 15<sup>th</sup> of the 11<sup>th</sup> mo<sup>e</sup> Ensuieing
