 begiⁿing at a post in the Street or Road that Leads through the said Township being
 a Corner deviding it from John Willmors Land from thenc^e South West by the said willmors
 Line of marked trees five hundred perches to a post set in the ground from thenc^e
 North West by a Line of marked trees one hundred and Sixty perches to another
 post set in the ground from thenc^e North East by a Line of marked trees five
 hundred perches to a post by the said Street or Road^e and by the same South
 East one hundred and Sixty perches to the place of begiⁿing Containeing and
 Laid out for five hundred acers of Land
