These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the sd tract of land laid out as aforesd according to ~~the~~ its true bounds and first lines of survey and to lay out to the sd Thomas Farmer in some convenient place where not already surveyd nor taken up ~~so~~ so much as the sd tract upon thy resurvey shall be found deficient as aforesaid and make returns of both into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this warrant is to remain & a copy thereof to be delivd to thee certified by the Secretary.
