That there was on the 2^d day of the 2^d month 1690. Survey^d and laid out unto Richard Townsend a certaine Lott of ground. On the bank of Skulob. on Society hill. Containing in breadth one hundred foot and in Length two hundred & fifty foot bounded to ye northward wth varrant Lotts Eastward with the River Delaware at ye said extent of two hundred and fifty foot southw^d wth Rich^d Walls Lott and to ye westw^d wth the new Street and was accordingly entred into the Surv^r Gen^ls office the _____ of the _____ Month _____
