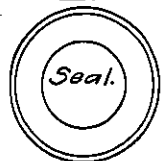

That we would grant him to take up his quantity of land proportionable to an Original Purchase of twelve hundred and fifty acres made by J^{rs} Tovey since purchased of the s^d John by the s^d Abiah: These are to authorize and require the s^d survey and lay out to the s^d Abiah Taylor within the bounds of the said Liberties on (obl) West side of Skuykill—Twenty acres of land that has not been already Survey'd and make returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 13th of the 3^d month 1703.
