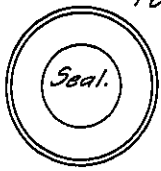


Pensylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

At the request of Richard Townsend of ^{ye City of} Philadelphia that we would grant him to take up a Lott of ground within ye said City in right of Edward Bettris original Purchaser of two Thousand acres of land in this Province, the right to which said lott being now in the said Richard, These are to authorize and require thee to survey & lay out or cause to be surveyed & laid out unto the said Richard Townsend in the vacancy between Sassafras and Mulberry Streets the said Lott of ground to contain in front nine & forty foot & half & the usual depth of the adjacent Lotts, and make a return thereof into the Secretarys office in order for a further Confirmation. Given under our hands & Provincial Seal at Philadelphia the 30th day of the 5th month Anno Domini 1716.
