At ye request of William Tanner, Purchaser of five hundred acres yt I would grant him to take up a lott in ye City of Philadelphia proportionable. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in any of ye streets sett out for Purchasers of ye sd Quantity, he fencing it in & building upon it, according to Regulation & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th 4th Mo. 1684.
