

By vertue of a wart from ye Govern^e dated ye 14th Instant, directed to me to survey unto Robt Turner three thousand acres, and two thousand six hundred, all lying together in ye County of Philadelphia. I hereby authorize thee to survey and set out unto him y^e five thousand six hundred acres joining together, as before mentioned where not already taken up according to ye new method of townships appointed by ye Govern^e and make me returns thereof w^{ch} are to remain on record in my office. Philadelphia ye 24th 12th mo. 1683.
