At ye request of Mary Vinte Widdow, yt I would grant her to take up a Lot^t in ye
City of Philadelphia: These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or
cause to be surveyd unto her a Lot^t about ye Centre, thirty foot front, & in
length as ye rest of ye same street run, she fencing it in & building upon
ye same within six months from the date of survey, & make returns
thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 15th of ye 5th
mo. 1684.
