to take up his Portion of land wthin ye Liberties of ye City. These are to will &
require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him one hundred
(o-b-l.) wthin ye bounds thereof on Tekony in a place not already taken up, ac-
cording to ye method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof
into my Secretarys office. Given at Philadelphia ye 14th of ye ^{mo.} 4th 1683.
