At ye request of Robert Fairman in right of Thomas Holme Purchaser of five Thousand acres, yt we would grant him to take up seven hundred acres of land, in part thereof in the County of Philadelphia. These are therefore in the Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him the said number of acres in the aforesaid County, where not already taken up according to the method of townshipp appointed by the Govern^r he seating and improveing the same wth in six moneths after the date of survey, and make returne thereof into the Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia the 23^d of ye 6th mo. 1684.
