These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ~~ye~~ a Lott in any of ye streets sett out for Purchasers of ye sd quantity, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office, he seating & improving ye same within six months from ye date of survey Given at Philadelphia ye 26th 5th mo 1684.
