 take up two thousand four hundred acres and fifty in part of their Purchase
 of five Thousand acres on ye Skullkill. These are to will and require thee
 forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto y^r ye 5^d number of acres
 in ye abovemention'd place, where not already taken up, according to
 ye Method of Townships appointed by me, and make returns thereof
 into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 22^d of ye 1st mo.
 1683.
