Pennsilvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.



At ye request of William Preston on behalf of John Tizaok (in ~~right~~ of George Green) Purchaser of one Thousand acres, yt we would grant him to take up his Lotts in ye city of Philadelphia. These are in ye Proprietarys & Govern^{rs} name to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyed unto him ye sd lotts where they fell, he fencing & building upon ye front lott & fencing in & clearing ye high street lott within six months from ye date of survey according to regulation, & make returns thereof into ye Secretary office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 26th of ye 3^d M^o 1683.
