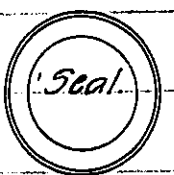


William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of ye Province of Pennsylvania,

At ye request of Nathanael Allen, Purchaser of Two Thousand Acres, yt I  
would grant him to take up his Lotts in Philadelphia: These are to will &  
requite three forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him his Lotts in ye  
front & high street where they fell, & make returns thereof into my  
secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 21<sup>st</sup> of ye 10<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683.
