

At a Special Meeting at the Governors on Wednesday the 18th day of March 1767.

Ordered that the Surveyor General send positive orders to the several Surveyors to survey as soon as possible & return all warrants issued to the proprietaries of Iron Works & that they include all Lands off which the Wood is cut.

At a Special Meeting at the Governors on Monday the 13th of April 1767.

Upon its being represented that many surveys are made and making which contain more land than the Warrant or Application Specifies. The Governor orders that no surveys be reced consisting of more than 10 P Cent over & above the quantity specified in the Warrant or Application.
