



Pursuant to a warrant from ye proprietors Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of Property bearing date ye 18<sup>th</sup> day of ye 12<sup>th</sup> month 170<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> directed unto me I certify that I have resurveyed ye 13<sup>th</sup> of ye 1<sup>st</sup> mo<sup>o</sup> ensuing unto Capt Sam<sup>l</sup> Finney a certaine tract of land in ye County of Philadelphia beginning at a Chestnut marked in a line of Joseph Fishers land and being a corner dividing it from Tho. Siddno land from thence by a line of marked trees & same land south west 503 perches to a stake sett in ye ground nere a white oak marked in ye reputed Susquehanna Roade. from thence by a line of marked trees & said Roade south east 267 perches to a black oak sapling dividing it from ye reputed land of Robert Wilkins from thence by a line of marked trees & same land north east 503 perches to a stake sett in ye ~~ground~~ line of ye above sd Fisher from thence by ye sd line north west 267 per<sup>s</sup> to ye place of beginning. Cont<sup>d</sup> 839<sup>as.</sup> 1/2 71 perches & is according to ye above bounds Returned into ye Generall Survey<sup>rs</sup> office at Philadelphia ye 14<sup>th</sup> day of ye sd 1<sup>st</sup> mo<sup>o</sup>.
