At ye request of John Tibby, yt I would(-obl-) him a warrant to take up a City Lott proper(-obl-) riable to his Purchase, ~~five~~ <sup>two</sup> hundred & fifty acres these are to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be surveyd unto him in ye ~~Street~~ street on Delaware, sett out for Purchasers of ye like number of acres, a Lot to build on where not taken up, & make returns thereof to my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 6<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> 1770 1683.
