thee forth wth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd prop-
ortion wth in ye Bounds thereof, he seating & improving ye same
according to Regulation & make returns thereof into my Secretary's
office. Given at Philadelphia ye 19th of ye 5th mo. 1684.
