ye Lott in ye City of Philadelphia he bought of Edmond Lovett of  
Two hundred & fifty Acres. These are to will and require the fort-  
hw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him in a Street sett out for  
Purchasers of ye like quantity a Lott in a place not already taken  
up and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given  
at Philadelphia ye 21<sup>st</sup> of ye 3<sup>d</sup> mo. 1683.
