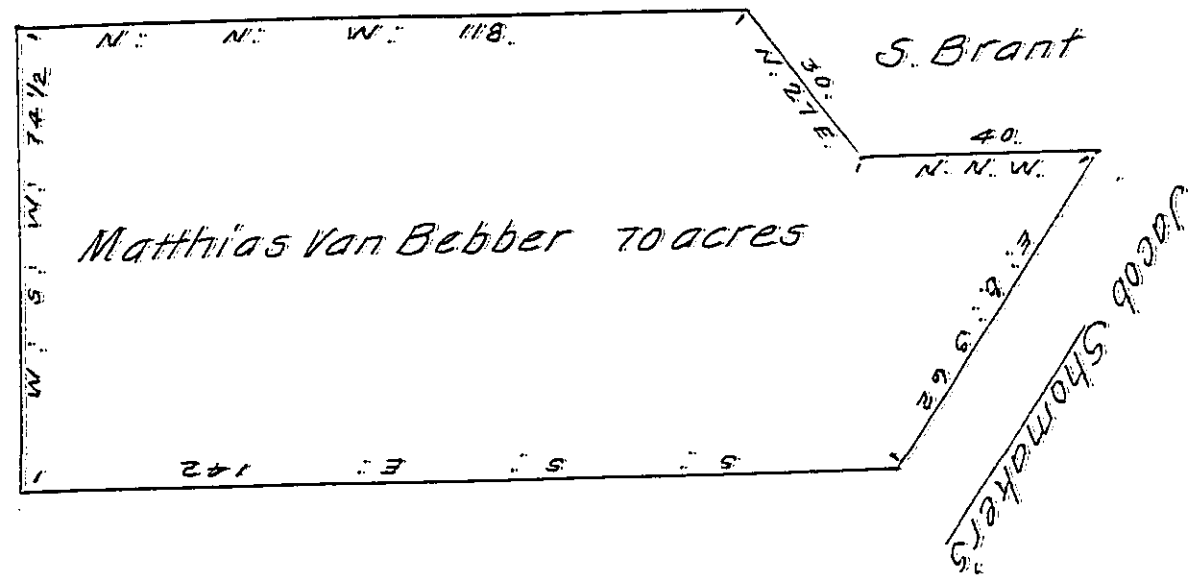


## Susannah Brant



Pursuant to a Warrant from the Commiss<sup>rs</sup> of prop<sup>ty</sup> directed unto me bearing date ye 14<sup>th</sup> day of ye 10<sup>th</sup> mo 1702. I do Certify that I have Resurveyed unto Matthias Van Bebber a Certain parcell of Land in ye Liberty of Philladelphia beginning at a Cor. Stake-being a Corner of Susanna Brants Land from thence-by a Line of Marked trees & ye same Land North North West 118 perches to another Stake-thence-North 27 degrees East 30 perches.thence-North North West 40 perches to a Stake-in a Line of Jacob Sheemakers Land.thence-by a Line of Marked trees & ye same Land East & by ~~62~~<sup>South</sup> 62 perches to a Stake-set in ye ground near a Spanish Stake. Marked thence-South South East 142 perches to a post set in ye ground.thence-by a Line of Marked trees West South West 74 1/2 perches to ye place of beginning. Containing 70 acres of Land and is according to ye bounds above described. Returnd into ye Generall Survey<sup>rs</sup> office at Philladelphia the 15 day of ye 12<sup>th</sup> mo and year above Resited
