



In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property dated the 5th of The Third month 1729. Survey'd and laid out to Dereck Janson a Tract of land at Secana in the County of Philad^a. beginning at a White oak. thence by Vacant land South Seventy degrees West three hundred and Twenty perches to a Chesnut oak. thence by Vacant land South Twenty degrees East Two hundred Sixty five perches to a White oak. thence by Vacant land North Seventy degrees East three hundred and Twenty perches to a post in the line of Lawrence Switzer's land. Thence by the same North Twenty degrees West Two hundred Sixty five perches to the place of beginning. Containing five hundred Acres with the usual Allowance. Surveyed Feb^r 20th - 8.
