At the Request of Philip James That I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land Scituate in the County of Philadelphia on the River Skuykill laid out for four hundred Acres for Charles Jones of Bristol. These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the Said Tract according to the true Bounds and first Lines of Survey. And make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 15<sup>th</sup> of the first Month 1709.
