These are to will & require thee forthw.<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott <sup>on Skulkill</sup> in any of ye Streets sett out for Purchasers of ye same Quantity, and make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia, ye 1<sup>st</sup> of ye 7<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1683.
