ye City of Philadelphia, proportionable to his Purchase of Two  
hundred & fifty Acres. These are to will & require thee forthwith  
to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a Lott in a street sett  
out for Purchasers of ye like Quantity on Skulkill. - & make re-  
turns there of into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philade-  
lphia ye 17<sup>th</sup> <sup>mo</sup> 4<sup>th</sup> 1683.
