At the Request of Derrick Jansen of German Town That we would Grant him to take up Five hundred Acres of Land in this Province the Original purchase of Thomas Parkhurst. Citizen & Stationer of London made of the Propriet. by Deeds of Lease & Release dated the 22^d & 23^d days of March Anno-1685. The right to which being now Vested in the Said Derrick. These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto the Said Derrick Jansen in the Said Province According to the Method of Townships appointed the Said quantity of Five hundred Acres of Land that has not been Already Survey'd nor appropriated nor is Seated by the Indians, and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation. Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 28th day of ye 6th Month Anno Din. 1719.
